# DATE OF REPORT: 2.2.2024 PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

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We are currently conducting Advance Voting training classes for the Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) Election, and it is going great. The curriculum for the training is structured with Extensive Hands-on experience and I am pleased to report that we have received positive feedback on the new cellular poll pad from AV staff. We are preparing for our first day of Advance Voting which is scheduled to begin on February 19th.

# Part-Time Shift Program:

We successfully introduced part-time staffing opportunities for the clerk and monitoring positions during the 2023 election cycle and we are excited to continue the program to interested applicants.

We have completed the following necessary goals to successfully conduct the Presidential Preference Primary election:

- 1) Review and revise our existing training curriculum.
- 2) Rapidly realign elements of the training curriculum to incorporate utilizing the cellular poll pad and the newly adopted GARVIS. (Georgia Registered Voter Information System)
- Develop and produce a training manual and related classroom materials.
- 4) Develop and implement a real-time EV Location monitoring and review system, including hourly reconciliation and activity reporting. This allows us to rapidly identify errors, weaknesses or other failures occurring as a result of less-than-optimal procedures or processes and apply timely corrective measures.

# **FINANCE**

#### DATE OF REPORT: | 02/01/2024

#### PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

The Fulton County Board of Commissioners (BOC) has issued the final approval of the 2024 Elections and Operations budgets. The 2024 Elections budget was reduced to \$34 million. This is a \$1 million reduction to our elections budget. We have adjusted our Elections budget for the \$1 million reduction. The Finance department has provided the 2024 Elections and Operations funding in the AMS accounting system.

The BOC approved 2024 Elections budget is funding for the 1<sup>st</sup> four election cycles for 2024. The Finance department's plan is to fund the December 2024 General run-off election, if needed, from the overall Fulton County underruns.

The Financial Systems manager has managed the two temporary staffing agencies to onboard returning temporary employees in January 2024. We continue to meet with the temporary staffing agencies to coordinate their recruiting efforts to fill open temporary positions. We are processing January 2024 invoices to submit for the 2024 budget.

We are awaiting the issuance of new 2024 Purchase orders as we wait for some of the Fulton County systems to be restored due to the cybersecurity issues that occurred in late January 2024.

The remaining balances of the 2023 November and December municipal elections budget were rolled over into 2024 to fund the rest of the 2023 municipal election expenses. We are tracking the 2023 budget to actual costs analysis to ensure we adhere to the municipal election budget. We are continuing to process vendor invoices received for the 2023 municipal elections. We are following up with vendors who have not submitted their 2023 invoices to us.

#### PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

March 12<sup>th</sup> Presidential Preference Primary Election: The Information Systems staff begin preparation for the March 12<sup>th</sup> Presidential Preference Primary Election. The main items in preparation are listed below.

- **Training** The Information Systems staff completed voting equipment and setup equipment used in Advance Voting Training from January 23<sup>rd</sup> February 16<sup>th</sup>. Also, the Information Systems staff completed voting equipment used in Election Day Poll Worker Training which started on January 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- Logic & Accuracy Testing Logic & Accuracy Testing begin on January 16<sup>th</sup> and will continue through March 7<sup>th</sup>. The Information Systems staff completed Logic & Accuracy Testing and program all equipment for Advance Voting. Advance Voting equipment was handed off to the logistics division for delivery to the Advance Voting sites beginning on February 13<sup>th</sup>. Also, the Information Systems staff started and continue to conduct Logic & Accuracy Testing and program all equipment for Election Day. The Information Systems staff will conduct Logic & Accuracy testing and complete updates on all Poll Pads used at Advance Voting sites and have these Poll Pads completed by February 16<sup>th</sup>.
- **Technical Support** The Information Systems staff will provide technical support for Advance Voting which starts on February 19<sup>th</sup> and ends on March 8<sup>th</sup>.

# **VOTER EDUCATION**

DATE OF REPORT: January 31, 2024

## PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

In January, The Voter Education and Outreach team focused on continuing to create a database of Senior communities located within Fulton County. The VEO Manager sent correspondence to every location, organization, or person requesting an event last year to begin scheduling events for the 2024 election season. The VEO manager also hosted several poll worker recruitment fairs in College Park, Roswell, Chattahoochee Hills, Johns Creek, and Milton.

The VEO manager participates in legislative meetings as needed to discuss all bills introduced that impact the elections department and attends committee meetings to listen to the hearings on all election bills. The VEO manager also serves on the legislative committee for GAVERO.

The VEO manager continued the partnership with the High Museum of Art by conducting outreach events at the facility to promote the 2024 election cycle. The VEO manager is also conducting Deputy registrar training and working with Deputy Registrars to conduct voter registration drives at the Atlanta Public Schools. She is also working to organize voter registration drives at Fulton County High Schools and the private high schools in the county. The VEO team has begun outreach with the colleges and universities in the county to start scheduling outreach events on all the campuses while promoting the early voting outreach schedule. The VEO team also has begun outreach to all Fulton County libraries to organize outreach events at their facilities.

The VEO Manager met with the external affairs team to discuss collateral for the 2024 election cycle and continues to work to coordinate any request for interviews. Once all collateral has been received, The VEO team will work to send it out to all partners, municipalities, schools, and Libraries. In February, THE VEO team is focusing on educating the Fulton County citizens on the redistricting changes and scheduling events in the areas indicated on the Carter Center Report that need more Voter Education.

The VEO team is continuously planning events and will continue contacting schools, communities, non-profit organizations, and government officials to schedule future events across the county.
