FULTON COUNTY WORKERS' COMPENSATION AFTER HOURS PROCEDURES

Injuries that occurs after business hours, weekends, and holidays, the employee can choose to go to the nearest facility listed below, however you must follow-up with the Workers' Compensation Division the next business day.

- 2. Caduceus Medical Center 535 North Central Ave. Hapeville, GA. 30354, 770-761-4008
- 3. Grady Hospital Emergency Room, 80 Jesse Hill Jr. Dr. Atlanta, GA. 30303

Claims consideration will be given for treatment by an emergency medical facility after hours, weekends, and holidays only in a dire emergency situation at the emergency facility nearest to the scene of the accident or injury. (If you are treated by an emergency treating facility and not hospitalized, you **MUST** contact the Workers' Compensation Division to be seen by one of the authorized treating facilities listed on the Official Notice for authorization the following work day.) **DO NOT GO TO AN EMERGENCY FACILITY FOR MINOR INJURY OR DURING A NORMAL WORK DAY.**

It's necessary that the accident reports be received in the Workers' Compensation Division within 48 hours after the accident or injury. Failure to meet this deadline may endanger the receipt of workers' compensation benefits by the injured employee.
